

#### WHAT IS MESSAGE SCHOOL OF EVANGELISM?

MESSAGE SCHOOL OF EVANGELISM (MSE) IS AN OPPORTUNITY TO GROW YOUR HEART FOR THOSE WHO DON'T YET KNOW JESUS, AND DEVELOP YOUR ABILITY TO REVEAL THE GOSPEL FROM YOUR LIPS AND YOUR LIFE.

If you want to understand the gospel deeply, grow in your faith and learn what it means to offer hope to a world in need, then join us for ten months that will change your life.

While on MSE, you'll have many opportunities to proclaim and demonstrate the gospel. You'll receive powerful teaching from experienced tutors at The Message Trust and our partners around the world, which will train and release you to live a worshipful life through local church mission. And that's not all! Putting everything into practice, you'll take the gospel to the streets, schools, prisons and local communities across the UK and beyond.

WHAT IS EVANGELISM?

Evangelism is all about sharing the good news of Jesus with the world who desperately need to hear it. It's something we're all called to do.
Think of it like this:

"Evangelism is one beggar showing another beggar where they can find bread". We know how precious Jesus is having received him and we want to take him and offer him out as bread that will sustain a world who is starving without him.

Or even "Evangelism is joining in with the conversation the Holy Spirit is already having with a person". We want to know Jesus so relationally and deeply that as we hear his voice, we even can think about what he's saying to others and be his mouthpiece and his people to a world who need to hear the hope of his name.

MSE is part of the award winning Christian charity The Message Trust, based in Manchester, UK.

The Message Trust is a worldwide movement passionately sharing the love of Jesus Christ in words and actions with the hardest-to-reach young people and communities.

#### LIVING IN MANCHESTER

Known for its football teams, music and universities, Manchester is a city full of life and culture. Whether it's going to the national football museum, shopping at The Trafford Centre, or eating in the vibrant Northern Quarter, you'll love living here.





#### **FEES**

The cost of MSE is £3,000 for the year. This covers your course fees including all classes, placements and all of your accommodation costs and bills (e.g. gas, electricity, WiFi etc). A £200 non-refundable deposit is required once you are accepted onto the course. The full balance is due in the September you start.

#### **COST OF LIVING**

You'll also need a recommended personal allowance of around £250 a month. This is to cover your food and travel costs. We'll help you with fundraising and encourage you to find personal monthly supporters to help you cover the costs. Don't feel overwhelmed by this financial challenge – please talk to us and we can journey with you through different stages of fundraising and finances.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

You'll be based in Wythenshawe, South Manchester, where you'll live alongside our urban missionary movement Eden, learning what it looks like to reach people with the good news of Jesus right where you're living. You'll live with other MSE students and all accommodation is accessible to The Message campus either by walking or by bus.

#### **CHURCH**

Being an active part of a local church is an essential part of MSE. During the year, you'll be placed with the church that meets at The Message campus called Message Community Church (MCC). The church is an exciting place to be where people from the local community of Wythenshawe are regularly giving their lives to God and learning what it means to be a follower of Jesus.





#### NOW YOU'VE BEEN TRAINED, THIS TERM YOU'LL BE SENT

You'll head out on mission across the UK. Whether it's working in schools, on community projects, doing street outreach or something new, you'll work together to deliver mission wherever you go.

And that's not all. You'll also have the opportunity to go on an overseas mission trip! Previous trips have headed to South Africa, Germany, India and Kenya working with young people and communities.

## **WHAT DOES** THE YEAR **LOOK LIKE?**

#### IN TERM TWO, WE WANT TO GIVE YOU A CHANCE TO GROW AND BE STRETCHED

You'll get to head out on mission projects, with chances to serve and even lead.

You'll be put into smaller teams and start working on your own mission materials such as preparing school lessons and planning gospel talks.

#### AT THE START OF MSE THE FOCUS IS TEACHING AND TRAINING

Equipping you with Biblical knowledge and practical training so that you become more confident in the gospel, deepen your relationship with God and find new ways to put your faith into action, teaching is at our heart.

Right from the start, we don't just talk about mission - we do it. You'll spend time out on placement with our partner church.

# INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

We have a lot of international students join us on MSE and we're really excited to welcome you, wherever in the world you're from.

To make sure the process is as simple as possible, and to ensure that your charity worker visa\* arrives in time we'd recommend you applying for the school as soon as possible, with the deadline for international applications being 1 June.

If you're worried about the visa application process we have staff here who can help you.

\*Please note the cost of a charity worker visa will cost around £1300, this cost includes the use of the NHS healthcare system.

#### **CAN I ATTEND AN OPEN DAY?**

### WILL I GET A JOB/CHANCE TO WORK FOR THE MESSAGE AT THE END?

We can't promise that anyone will get a job with The Message after MSE finishes, but we are committed to helping you find the right way to use your gifts in ministry beyond the course. Sometimes that can mean working with The Message, but many students go on to be part of other ministries or opportunities such as university or career opportunities elsewhere.

#### **CAN I GET A PART TIME JOB?**

MSE is a full-time school so there will not be time to find paid work at the same time. It is advised that you try to raise all the money you'll need before the start of the year or ask people to sponsor you on a monthly basis to cover your costs. (We have people who will be able to help you with fundraising if you need it.)

#### **DO WE GET HOLIDAYS?**

We follow UK academic holidays with two weeks off at Christmas and Easter, a weeks half term in October and February, as well as bank holidays.
