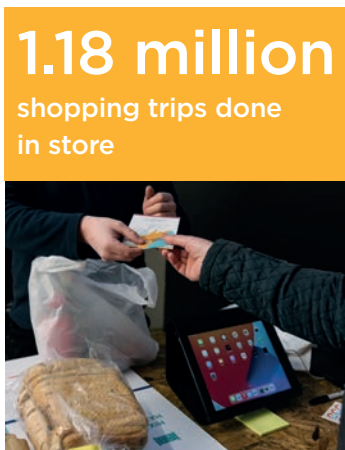

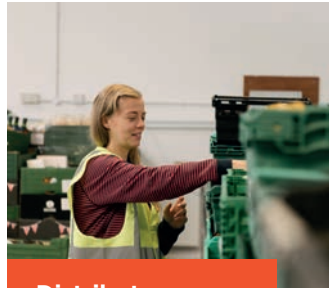
LOOKING AHEAD
